

## Multimodal Cooperative Resolution of Referential Expressions in the DENK System

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Because of the different modalities involved in the interaction, the system is suited to handle multimodal references to objects: a user can select an object and use a deictic term, or can refer to something that is visible on the screen by means of a pronoun.
